

1. Answer – B) United States**Explanation:**

Air forces of the United States and India will take part in a 12-day joint exercise 'Cope India 2019' (CI19) at two air force stations in West Bengal from December 3 to 14, 2018. The exercise will be held at Air Station Kalaikunda and Air Station Arjan Singh (Panagarh) in West Bengal. This exercise is conducted after a gap of 8 years. The previous edition of this exercise was held in 2010. This is a bilateral US Pacific Air Forces (PACAF) sponsored Field Training Exercise (FTX). This will focus on US-Indian mutual cooperation and building on existing capabilities, aircrew tactics and force employment. Around 200 US Airmen with 15 aircraft from the 18th Wing, Kadena Air Base, Japan and 182nd Airlift Wing, Illinois Air National Guard will participate on behalf of United States.

2. Answer – B) Manipur Explanation:

From 21st November to 30th November, Manipur Tourism Department organized an annual cultural festival known as "Sangai Festival" which was previously known as "Tourism Festival". But in 2010 it was renamed after the State Animal of Manipur Sangai Deer. The Sangai Festival is celebrated to promote Manipur as the World Class tourism destination. The Festival showcases the culture, handloom, handicraft and fine arts, Cuisines and Music, Indigenous sports, Adventure sports as well as the scenic natural beauty of the Manipur. Sangai Festival is celebrated at Keibul Lamjao & Loktak Lake, Hapte Kangjeibung and Bheigyachandra Open Air Theatre, Mapal Kangjeibung and Khuman Lampak, Kangshang, Trade & Permanent Exhibition Centre at Lamboi Khongnangkhang.

3. Answer – A) Pune, Maharashtra**Explanation:**

On 29th and 30th November 2018, the Indian Owl Festival, India's first owl fest, was held at Pingori village in Purandar taluka of Pune, Maharashtra. The festival was organised by Ela Foundation. It created awareness on owl conservation and feature art forms like pictures, paintings, lanterns, lamp shades, posters, origami, stitched articles, poems and stories on owls. The festival featured skits and short films on owls. Out of the 262 species of owls that are found in the world, 75 are threatened. As per a report of Traffic India, a wildlife trade monitoring body, and the World Wildlife Fund (WWF) in 2010, owls were found to be consumed and traded for black magic, street performances, taxidermy, private aviaries/zoos, food, folk medicines, etc. They are protected under the Wildlife (Protection) Act of India.

4. Answer – D) Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia**Explanation:**

On 27th November 2018, the 3rd ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) India Business Summit was organised by the ASEAN India Business Council (AIBC) Malaysian Chapter in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The Summit consisted of 3 events: ASEAN India Business Conference, ASEAN India Business Excellence Awards and Gala Dinner. It was organized under the guidance of Ministry of International Trade and Industries. The award ceremony was presided by the Malaysian Minister of International Trade and Industry YB Datuk Ignatius Darell Leiking. ASEAN – India Business Summit honours businessmen from the ASEAN and Indian Business community with special achievement awards.

5.**Answer – C) eDrishti Explanation:**

On November 29, 2018, the Indian Railways launched a software named- 'eDrishti', that will enable the Union Railway Minister Shri. Piyush Goyal to keep track of punctuality of trains as well as freight and passenger earnings from anywhere in the country. The software has been developed by the Centre for Railway Information System (CRIS). This would enable the railway minister to know the following:

- A day's freight and passenger earnings,
- Freight loading and unloading,
- Punctuality,
- The progress of major projects,
- Public grievances,
- The movement of trains across the country,
- Details of railway stations,
- Video monitoring of the IRCTC kitchens,
- Live status of reserved and unreserved passengers travelling on trains.

The software has also been connected with the base kitchens of the Indian Rail Catering and Tourism Corp (IRCTC).

6. Answer – B) Nagaland Explanation:

The 19th Hornbill Festival 2018 is celebrated from 1st to 10th December 2018 in Nagaland. It is celebrated at the Naga Heritage Village in Kisama, located around 12 kilometers from the capital of the Nagaland, Kohima. The Hornbill Festival is one of the most cherished festivals of Nagaland. It is named after Hornbill, one of the most venerated bird species in the state. The 10-day festival is celebrated annually during the first week of December, i.e. from December 1-10. It is organized by State Tourism and Arts and Culture Department, Government of Nagaland to encourage inter-tribal harmony and promote culture and traditions of the different tribes of the state.

7. Answer – D) Odisha Explanation:

India's first international indigenous film festival will take place in February next year in Odisha. It will be an initiative of activist film collective 'Video Republic'. The three-stop event will kick off in Bhubaneswar on February 19 and 20, moving on to Puri from February 21 to 23 and will eventually culminate in an interaction with the adivasi communities at Niyamgiri. Films made by indigenous people or made by non-indigenous filmmakers in collaboration with the indigenous communities will be shown in the event.

8. Answer – C) India Explanation:

On 30th November 2018, a report by UNICEF (United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund) which was released ahead of AIDS day estimated that 1,20,000 children and adolescents aged 0-19 were living with HIV in India in 2017, the highest number in South Asia. The report titled 'Children, HIV and AIDS: The World in 2030' warned that around 80 adolescents will be dying of AIDS every day globally by 2030 if progress in preventing transmission is not accelerated. In India, an estimated 120,000 children and adolescents aged 0-19 were living with HIV in 2017. In Pakistan, this number was 5800, followed by Nepal (1,600) and Bangladesh (less than 1,000). In 2017, the estimated number of children under 5 years old newly diagnosed with HIV was 43 per cent lower than the comparable estimate in 2010 a decline greater than the 35 per cent recorded globally. "The report makes it clear, without the shadow of a doubt, that the world is off track when it comes to ending AIDS among children and adolescents by 2030," said UNICEF chief Henrietta Fore.

9.

Answer – C) Australia Explanation:

On November 30, 2018, Australia became the first country in the world to criminalize the act of falsely inducing children into orphanages as a form of slavery. The Modern Slavery Bill was passed by both houses of parliament and under it the new law, so-called "orphanage trafficking" will be treated as a slavery and trafficking offense. Evidence shows that about 80 per cent of these children have family who could care for them if they had the right support.

10.

Answer – D) Abhinav Bindra

Explanation:

On November 30, 2018, India's Olympic and world champion shooter Abhinav Bindra was conferred the Blue Cross, the ISSF's highest award at the General Assembly in Munich. He is the first Indian to be awarded the Blue Cross. It was bestowed upon him for his outstanding services as the chairman of the International Shooting Sport Federation's Athletes Committee. Also the committee has brought out a comprehensive Athletes Handbook, for the benefit of shooters around the world. Bindra was succeeded in the post by the American shooter Kimberly Rhode.

Answer – A) Salome Zurabishvili

Explanation:

66 Years old Salome Zurabishvili has won Georgia's presidential election, becoming the first woman to hold the office in the country. She will take oath for the office on 16th December 2018. The French-born ex-diplomat, backed by the ruling Georgian Dream party, had taken 59.52 % of the total votes and defeated her rival candidate Grigol Washadze who received 40.5% of the votes. The election was seen as a test of Georgia's democratic credentials as it seeks European Union and NATO membership. She had served as Foreign Minister of Georgia from March 20, 2004 to October 19, 2005 and was previously an ambassador in the French Foreign Service.

12. Answer – B) United States

Explanation:

On December 1, 2018, the former United States President George HW Bush passed away at 94. He was the 41st president of the United States and had been in leadership during the end of the Cold War.

Answer – C) Ranchi, Jharkhand

Explanation:

On November 29 2018 the two-day Global Agriculture and Food summit had been inaugurated by Union Agriculture Minister Radha Mohan Singh in Tana Bhagat Stadium, Khel Gaon at Ranchi, Jharkhand. Governor of Jharkhand Droupadi Murmu was the chief guest for the closing ceremony on November 30. Nearly 10,000 farmers from the Jharkhand had participated in the Summit. Experts in agriculture, research, educationists in agriculture institutions and universities, companies related to agriculture business were also participated in the summit. Tunisia, China, Israel, Philippines and Mongolia are participating as associated countries in International session. Government of Jharkhand is organizing Agri Trade Exhibition during Global Agriculture and Food Summit 2018 on 29-30th November 2018 at Ranchi.

14. Answer – A) United States**Explanation:**

On 1st December 2018, The Special Forces of India and United States completed the final maneuvers of their three-day tactical exercise called 'Vajra Kayaa' which is part of their joint military drill 'Vajra Prahar 2018' in Jaipur. Vajra Kayaa was based on narrative of an imaginary country going into a civil war due to weak democratic structure and which has now been taken over by armed terrorists.

Answer – D) Kathmandu, Nepal**Explanation:**

On December 1 2018 two day Asia Pacific Summit-2018 has started in Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal. This summit was organized by South Korea-based Universal Peace Federation and supported by the Government of Nepal. This summit has attended by 1500 participants from 45 countries including India. Focus on various global issues including peace, development, good governance and role of parliamentarians, climate change and role of media. Theme 2018 is "Addressing the Critical Challenges of Our Time: Interdependence, Mutual Prosperity, and Universal Values".

16. Answer – B) Raninder Singh**Explanation:**

On 1st December 2018, Raninder Singh became the first Indian to be elected as the vice-president of the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF). The elections were held during the General Assembly meeting of ISSF in Munich in which Raninder secured 161 votes to make it to the coveted position. The 51-year-old Raninder is currently the president of the National Rifle Association of India (NRAI). The NRAI president was also awarded the ISSF diploma of honour gold medal at the General Assembly by the outgoing longest serving president of the ISSF, Olegario Vazquez Rana, who was at the helm for 38 years. Vladimir Lisin, of Russia was elected as the seventh president of ISSF and Alexander Rather was elected as the new secretary general of ISSF in the same General Assembly meeting. Also Indian Shooter and 2008 Olympic gold medalist, Abhinav Bindra was honoured with the prestigious Blue Cross, the highest recognition of the ISSF in the meeting. He is the now the first Indian be conferred with shooting's highest award.

18. Answer – A) USD 200 billion**Explanation:**

On 3rd December 2018, the World Bank unveiled USD 200 billion in climate action investment for 2021-25, adding this amounts to a doubling of its current five-year funding. The move coincides with a UN climate summit in Katowice (Poland). The breakdown of 200 billion dollars would comprise approximately 100 billion in direct finance from the World Bank. Around one-third of the remaining funding will come from two World Bank Group agencies with the rest private capital mobilised by the World Bank Group. In the 2018 fiscal year, running from July 2017 to June 2018, the World Bank had committed USD 20.5 billion to climate action, compared with an annual average of USD 13.5 billion for the 2014-2018 period. UN climate summit started on 03rd December 2018 in Katowice (Poland) with a warning that today's generation is the last that can prevent catastrophic global warming, as well as the first to be suffering its impacts. This Climate conference has been called as Paris 2.0. Agreement saw countries commit to limiting global temperature rises to well below two degrees Celsius (3.6 degrees Fahrenheit), and to the safer cap of 1.5C if at all possible.

19. Answer – A) 7.2 % Explanation:

On 03rd December 2018, Moody's expects the real gross domestic product (GDP) in India to grow 7.2 per cent in the year ending March 2019 and 7.4 per cent in the following year. Earlier Moody's Investors service growth prediction for India was 7.5% in 2018-19, 7.5% in 2019-20 released on 23rd August, 2018. This growth is driven by investment growth and strong consumption. Moody's said in its report it has a stable outlook on the Indian

banking system for the next 12-18 months. The stable outlook is based on six parameters — operating environment, asset quality, capital, funding and liquidity, profitability and efficiency, and government support.

20. Answer – B) Pawan Singh

Explanation:

On 2nd December 2018, Pawan Singh became the first Indian to be elected as one of the 7 members of the Judges Committee of the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF). Pawan Singh is also the Joint Secretary General of National Rifle Association of India (NRAI). He was a former coach of the Indian shooting team. Members of the administrative council of ISSF voted to select the committee, at the elections held at Munich. The Judges Committee consists of: a Chairman and 7 members. It is responsible for the uniform application of shooting rules. It offers guidelines for international judges. It prepares and conducts courses for judges and jury members. It approves applications for judge's licenses' and proposes juries to the executive committee for championships and games. It meets at least once a year and reports to the administrative council.

21. Answer – C) Ullas Narayan

Explanation:

On 2nd December 2018, Ullas Narayan became the first Indian individual medal winner in an international ultra running event by winning bronze in the 2018 International Association of Ultra Running (IAU) 24 Hour Asia & Oceania Championships in Taipei, Taiwan. Ullas Narayan secured third position as he completed 250 km. He finished behind Japanese runners Yoshihiko Ishikawa (253 km) and Nobuyuki Takahashi (252 km). Indian team, comprising Ullas Narayan (250 km), Sunil Sharma (202 km) and L L Meena (192 km), also won a bronze medal with their combined distance of 644 km. In the team event, Japan won gold with a distance of 756 km and Australia got silver with 684 km.

22. Answer – D) Japan Explanation:

On December 3, 2018, the first 5-day bilateral air exercise "SHINYUU Maitri-18" between India and Japan, commenced at the Air Force station in Agra in northern state of Uttar Pradesh. The theme of the exercise is: 'Joint mobility and humanitarian assistance and disaster relief (HADR) on transport aircraft'. It would be attended by: The Japanese Air Self Defence Force (JASDF) from Japan's side and Indian Air Force (IAF) from the Indian side. The JASDF's 'C27 aircraft is participating along with IAFs 'AN-32' and 'C-17'.

23. Answer – D) India Explanation:

The 14th edition of the G20 summit will be held in Japan while Saudi Arabia will host the 15th. India upon attaining 75 years of Independence on 2022 will host the G-20 Summit in 2022, which was previously scheduled to be hosted by Italy. The 2017 edition of G-20 Summit was held in Hamburg, Germany. The Group of Twenty (G20) is a leading forum of the world's major economies that seeks to develop global policies to address challenges. The G20 is made up of 19 countries and the European Union. The 19 countries are Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, Germany, France, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Turkey, the United Kingdom and the United States.

24. Answer – B) Buenos Aires, Argentina

Explanation:

On November 30, 2018, the two day 13th G-20 Summit commenced at Buenos Aires in Argentina. It was hosted by President of Argentina, Mr. Mauricio Macri. The theme of the 2018 edition of the Summit was: "Building Consensus for Fair and Sustainable Development". It had 3 sub-themes for the summit. They were:

- The first was 'Putting People First' that focused on the global economy, on the economic outlook or the future of work.
- The second session talks of Building Consensus, a topic of importance at this time certainly, and this will deal with international trade, finance, taxation, sustainable development and climate change and
- The third session is called 'Embracing Opportunities' and these are related to energy, infrastructure, sustainable food security.

On December 3, 2018, the Government of India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed a \$85 million loan in New Delhi, under the Odisha Skill Development Project to promote skill development in Odisha. This project would also receive a \$2 million technical assistance grant from the Japan Fund for Poverty Reduction, financed by the Government of Japan. It will be administered by ADB. The agreement was signed between:

- Additional Secretary in the Finance Ministry Sameer Kumar Khare and
- Country Director of ADB's India Resident Mission Kenichi Yokoyama.

26. Answer – D) Ada Hegerberg**Explanation:**

On 3rd December 2018, an annual football award, 2018 Ballon d'Or Award was announced. Real Madrid's Croatia midfielder Luka Modric was named winner of the 2018 Ballon d'Or. Ada Hegerberg was named as the First Recipient of Ballon d'Or Féminin award 2018. The award functions held in Paris (France). Juventus forward and 2017 winner Ronaldo came second, while Atletico Madrid and France striker Antoine Griezmann came third. Ada Hegerberg of Norway becoming the inaugural recipient of the Ballon d'Or Féminin award was followed by Pernille Harder of Denmark and Dzsenifer Marozsán of Germany. Paris St. Germain's France forward Kylian Mbappe, who also collected the Kopa award for the best under-21 player, was fourth, with Barca forward Messi finishing fifth. The Ballon d'Or is an annual football award presented by France Football. It has been awarded since 1956. The Ballon d'Or Féminin, also known as the Women's Ballon d'Or was also introduced by France Football that honours the best female association football player in the year 2018. 2018 FIFA World Cup held in Russia won by France beating Croatia in the finals. 2022 FIFA World Cup scheduled to take place in Qatar.

27. Answer – C) Ajay Narayan Jha**Explanation:**

On 3rd December 2018, Ajay Narayan Jha, the current expenditure secretary, in the Ministry of Finance has been appointed as the new finance secretary, by the Union Government. Ajay Narayan Jha, is a 1982-batch IAS officer of Manipur- Tripura cadre, and has succeeded Hasmukh Adhia who retired on November 30. Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led appointments committee of the Cabinet has cleared Jha's appointment to the post. Jha is an alumnus of St Stephens College. He is also an MPhil in public administration from Delhi University. Besides he is a recipient of World Bank scholarship to pursue masters in economic policy management from McGill University in Canada.

On 3rd December 2018, SpaceX founded by Elon Musk, launched India's first privately built satellite ExseedSAT 1 along with 63 other satellite from 18 countries from the Vandenberg air force base in California, USA. ExseedSAT 1 was built at a cost of Rs. 2 Crore by the Mumbai based Startup Exseedspace. ExseedSAT 1 which weighs around 1 kg is an open radio transponder that works on ham frequencies. The satellite will have a life span of 5 years and it will allow people to receive signals on 145.90 Mhz frequency with the help of a TV tuner.

31. Answer – B) Rs 485.38 crore

Explanation:

On December 6, 2018, the Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi approved implementation of Shahpurkandi Dam Project, Punjab on river Ravi. For this, central Assistance of Rs. 485.38 cr (for irrigation component) would be provided over five years from 2018-19 to 2022-23. This project would help minimising some of the water of the River Ravi which at present is going waste through the Madhopur Headworks downstream to Pakistan.

On December 5, 2018, Union Minister for Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation Shri Nitin Gadkari inaugurated 3-day annual India Water Impact Summit 2018 in New Delhi. On 08th December 2018, India retain its position as the world's top recipient of remittances this year with its diaspora sending \$80 billion back home, according to World Bank. India is followed by China (\$67 billion), Mexico and the Philippines (\$34 billion each) and Egypt (\$26 billion). The Bank estimates that officially recorded remittances to developing countries will increase by 10.8% to reach \$528 billion in 2018, against a 7.8% growth in 2017. Global remittances, which include flows to high-income countries, are projected to grow by 10.3 per cent to \$689 billion. Bangladesh and Pakistan both experienced strong upticks of 17.9 percent and 6.2 percent in 2018, respectively. For 2019, it is projected that remittances growth for the region will grow to 3.7 percent to \$715 billion. Reducing remittance flows to three per cent by 2030 is a global target under Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 10.7.

36. Answer – B) Amitabh Chaudhry

Explanation:

On 08th December 2018, Axis Bank inducted Amitabh Chaudhry as additional director on its board. He will replace incumbent Shikha Sharma whose fourth term has been curtailed by the RBI by nearly two-and-half years. The board also gave its nod for the reappointment of Samir Barua, Som Mittal and Rohit Bhagat as independent directors. Amitabh Chaudhry, the former MD and CEO of HDFC Standard Life Insurance Company, was in September named the MD and CEO of Axis Bank for a period of three years, with effect from January 1, 2019.

On December 7, 2018, Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers’ Welfare Shri Radha Mohan Singh announced Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) Council’s approval to India’s proposal to observe an International Year of Millets in 2023. This was approved in the 160th session of the Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) Council, being held in Rome. Millets consists of Jowar, Bajra, Ragi and minor millets together termed as nutri-cereals. After this win India became the Second Asian Country after Pakistan to win the Opening Test of a Series in Australia. The last Test India won in Australia was at the WACA Ground in Perth in 2008 under the Captaincy of Anil Kumble.

Explanation:

On December 10, 2018, the 14-day 7th Sino-India joint exercise Hand-in-Hand 2018, commenced at Chengdu, China. It will conclude on December 23, 2018. The Indian contingent consists of 11 SHIKKLI led by Col Puneet Pratap Singh Tomar, Commanding Officer, 11 SIKHLLI. The Chinese contingent consists of a regiment from Tibetan Military District of People's Liberation Army (PLA) led by Col Zhou Jun. The exercise will involve tactical level operations in an international counter insurgency/ counter terrorism environment under UN mandate.

On December 11, 2018, Government of India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed a loan agreement of 31 million dollars in New Delhi to develop Tourism and boost Jobs in Tamil Nadu. This was a tranche 4 loan for Infrastructure Development Investment Program for Tourism (IDIPT) for Tamil Nadu. On December 11, 2018, Sascha Bajin, coach of the world number five Naomi Osaka, became the first-ever recipient of the Women's Tennis Association (WTA) Coach of the Year Award. Under his guidance, Osaka won her career first WTA title at the Paribas Open (Indian Wells) and claimed her maiden Grand Slam title at the US Open after defeating American tennis ace Serena Williams. He also served as a Gold Member of the newly implemented WTA Coach Program.

Explanation:

On 10th December 2018, Karnataka's Kaiga Power Station-1 has created a world record for the longest uninterrupted operation for 941 days, thereby breaking the earlier record of 940 days by the United Kingdom. Heysham-2 Unit-8 of the U.K. had held the earlier record of the longest uninterrupted operation (940 days) among all nuclear power reactors (of all technologies) in the world. Kaiga Generating Station (KGS-A) equalled the world record on Sunday and broke it on Monday, thus creating history. While KGS-1 is a Pressurised Heavy Water Reactor (PHWR), Heysham-2 Unit-8 is an Advanced Gas Cooled Reactor (AGR).

50. Answer – A) Voyager 2**Explanation:**

On 10th December 2018, NASA's Voyager 2 probe became the second human-made object in history to reach the edge of our solar system i.e., the Interstellar space- the space between the stars. Voyager 2 probe now has exited the heliosphere – the protective bubble of particles and magnetic fields created by the Sun. Its twin, Voyager 1, crossed this boundary in 2012, but Voyager 2 launched 41 years ago in 1977, carries a working instrument that will provide first-of-its-kind observations of the nature of this gateway into interstellar space. Voyager 2 now is slightly more than 18 billion kilometres away from the Earth. Voyager 2 is the only spacecraft to have visited all four gas giant planets — Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune and discovered 16 moons, as well as phenomena like Neptune's mysteriously transient Great Dark Spot, the cracks in Europa's ice shell, and ring features at every planet.

51. Answer – B) 7.3 %**Explanation:**

On 12th December 2018, Asian Development Bank (ADB) in its supplement report "Asian Development Outlook (2018)" has retained India's FY19 growth forecast at 7.3% and 7.6% in FY20 despite downside risks posed by stress in the non-banking sector, limited fiscal space as well as escalating trade tensions. The country's GDP growth moderated to 7.1 per cent in second quarter of 2018-19 from 8.2 percent in the first quarter, averaging 7.6 per cent growth in the first half. India is maintaining growth momentum on rebounding exports and higher industrial and agricultural output. The slowdown came mainly from weak food prices, dampening rural consumption, higher oil prices delivering a negative shock in the terms of trade, and rising costs for raw materials.

52. Answer – B) Shaktikanta Das**Explanation:**

On 11th December 2018, Shaktikanta Das, former Economics Affairs Secretary appointed as 25th Governor of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). He succeeded Urjit Patel after he resigned from the post on 10th December 2018. Das is former Economic Affairs Secretary from 2015 to 2017, worked closely with the central bank. He is currently a member of the Finance Commission of India, and the government's representative at the Group of 20 summits. Urjit Patel resigned as the Governor of India's central bank citing personal reasons amid tensions between the government and the RBI over issues related to governance and autonomy of the central bank.

53. Answer – A) \$60 million**Explanation:**

On 13th December 2018, the Government of India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed a \$60 million loan agreement to reduce floods and the riverbank erosion in flood prone areas along the Brahmaputra river in Assam. The loan is part of the 120 million dollars multi-tranche financing facility (MFF) for the Assam integrated Flood and Riverbank Erosion Risk Management Investment Program approved by ADB in October 2010. The Program will fund a combination of structural and nonstructural measures in the three subproject areas of Palasbari-Gumi, Kaziranga, and Dibrugarh along the Brahmaputra river which include 20 km of riverbank protection works and upgrading of 13 km of flood embankments.

On December 12, 2018, the 2018 International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) Star Awards were held at the Grand Hyatt hotel in Incheon, Korea. Manika Batra became the first ever Indian Table Tennis player to be awarded the 'Breakthrough Table Tennis Star' award.

55. Answer – B) K. Chandrashekhar Rao**Explanation:**

On 13th December 2018 Telangana Rashtra Samiti (TRS) President K. Chandrashekhar Rao was sworn in as the Chief Minister of Telangana for the second term by Governor E.S.L. Narasimhan at a ceremony held at Raj Bhawan in Hyderabad. Party Member of Legislative Council Mohammed Mehmood Ali, who was deputy chief minister in the previous TRS government, took oath as a minister along with Rao. In the recently concluded assembly election the TRS won 88 seats in the 119-member assembly, defeating the Congress-led 'Praja Kutami'. This was the first Assembly elections in India's youngest state because the last elections were held in united Andhra Pradesh in 2014.

56. Answer – C) Russia

Explanation:

On December 11, 2018, Russian state-run atomic energy corporation Rosatom announced commencement of installation of Akademik Lomonosov, the world's first "floating" nuclear power plant (FNPP). It has a capacity of 70MW and is equipped with two reactors of 35MW each. The life span of the project is 40 years, with the possibility of being extended up to 50 years. After the completion of tests in March 2019, in the second half of 2019, the FNPP will be transported to its final destination to the port of Pevek in Russia's extreme north-eastern region of Chukotka. It will then replace the existing Bilibino Nuclear Power Plant and the Chaunskaya coal-fired power plant. It will be used to maintain both uninterrupted power and plentiful desalinated water supply in remote areas. This project will help the grid-isolated Russian Arctic regions.

58. Answer – B) Tata Steel Limited**Explanation:**

On 13th December 2018, Tata Steel Limited had been declared as the winner of the Prime Minister's Trophy for the 'Best Performing Integrated Steel Plant' in the country for the performance year 2016-17 making it the fourth consecutive year for Tata Steel being honoured with this coveted award. Along with the trophy a cash award of Rs. 2 crore was also given to the company. Having won the PM's Trophy 11 times and receiving the Certificate for Excellence twice, Tata Steel has been recognized as the best integrated steel plant 13 times, since the inception of this award in 1992-93. The Jammu and Kashmir Criminal Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2018 seeks to amend the Ranbir Penal Code (RPC)-a criminal code, whereby specific offence under section 354 E is being inserted to provide for the offence of 'Sextortion'. 'Sextortion' is a physical or non-physical form to extort sexual favours. People entrusted with power use 'sextortion' in a form of 'corruption'.

62.**Answer – A) Vadodara, Gujarat****Explanation:**

On December 15, 2018, Union Railways Minister Piyush Goyal and Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani dedicated the nation's first National Rail and Transportation Institute (NRTI) in Vadodara, Gujarat. It is India's first and world's 3rd railway university after Russia and China. The Vice-Chancellor of the university is Ashwani Lohani who is the Chairman of the Railway Board of India. The Ministry of Railways had sanctioned Rs. 421 crore for the upcoming 5 years for the operation of the project. It has been built on 110 acres of land at Pipaliya village in Waghodiya Taluka, District Vadodara.

63. Answer – D) Myanmar Explanation:

On December 12, 2018, the President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind paid his visit to the Advanced Centre for Agricultural Research and Education (ACARE) at the Yezin Agricultural University in Nay Pyi Taw. Here, he dedicated the Advanced Centre for Agricultural Research and Education to the people of Myanmar. It was established under the Bilateral Friendship Project and is funded by Government of India. The programme is run by Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI). The project focuses on genetics, post-harvest technology, participatory knowledge management and capacity building for farmers in Myanmar. He also dedicated a Rice Bio-Park in Yezin Agricultural University to the people of Myanmar. Projects under the park are undertaken by the M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation, funded by the Ministry of External Affairs. The projects are aimed at ensuring optimal use and value addition of the gamut of bio-sources in a rice farm, including rice straw and rice husk. He also launched a mobile app for farmers in Myanmar.

The reinstatement Mr. Wickremesinghe came after the Sri Lanka's Supreme Court ruled that President Sirisena had acted illegally in November by dissolving the Parliament before it completed its four-and-a-half year term, thus rejecting the Sirisena's attempts to hold snap elections in early January. The court later said Mahinda Rajapaksa should not exercise the powers of the office and ordered his resignation, seven weeks after he was appointed as the Prime Minister.

68. Answer – B) Virat Kohli Explanation:

On 16th December 2018, Indian Cricket Team captain Virat Kohli became the second fastest player to score 25 Test Centuries after scoring 123 runs on the third day of Second Test against Australia at Perth. Virat Kohli is only behind of former Australian captain and cricketing legend Sir Don Bradman. Virat Kohli also equalled Sachin Tendulkar's record of 6 Test Centuries in Australia.

Belgium won the tournament for the first time after defeating the Netherlands 3-2 in the final on a penalty shoot-out after a 0-0 draw. Australia won the third place by defeating England 8-1.

On 11th December 2018, the traditional delicacy of Nalanda district of Bihar, Silao Khaja which is popular among the tourists visiting Buddhist sites of Rajgir and Nalanda was granted GI tag by Geographical Indications Registry at Chennai. The application to obtain GI Tag was filed by Silao Khaja Audyogik Swavalambi Sahakari Simiti Limited, Bihar. Silao Khaja is a crisp, multi-layered dough sheeted sweet, made up of wheat-flour, sugar, maida, ghee, cardamom and aniseeds as ingredients. Environment factors including local water and climate like high ph levels

along with high Chlorine content of Silao region contribute to the puffiness and crispness of Khaja according to Public Health Division of Government of Bihar.

On 17th December 2018, the Indian Air Force flown India's first military flight using Blended Bio-Jet Fuel on an An-32 transport aircraft in Chandigarh. The project is a combined effort of IAF, DRDO, Directorate General Aeronautical Quality Assurance (DGAQA) and CSIR-Indian Institute of Petroleum. Air Chief Marshal BS Dhanoa had said the IAF intended to fly the An-32 with 10 per cent biojet fuel on Jan 26, 2019 Republic Day flypast. This fuel is made from Jatropa oil sourced from Chattisgarh Biodiesel Development Authority (CBDA) and then processed at CSIR-IIP, Dehradun. In August 2018, commercial airline Spicejet flew country's first ever bio-jet fuel-powered flight between Dehradun and Delhi.

76. Answer – C) Ministry of Commerce and Industry**Explanation:**

On 7th December 2018, the central government set up a new National Medical Devices Promotion Council (NMDPC) to plug loopholes in India's regulatory framework for medical devices to ensure safety of patients, pricing and restrictions on import of pre-owned equipment. The council will operate under Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, and will have 14 members, including representatives from the Health Ministry and Niti Aayog. Asma Jahangir was one of the four winners of the award which was announced by the United Nations in October and is given once in every five years since 1968. The three others who received the awards were: Ms. Rebeca Gyumi (Tanzania), Ms. Joenia Wapichana (Brazil) and Front Line Defenders (Irish organization). The award was given at the event organised to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, marked annually on December 10.

78. Answer – A) V Vaidyanathan**Explanation:**

On 18th December 2018, the Infrastructure Development Finance Company Bank (IDFC Bank) and non-banking financial company Capital First completed their merger process, creating a combined loan asset book of Rs 1.03 lakh crore for the merged entity IDFC First Bank, which will be headquartered in Mumbai. GSAT-7A is the 39th Indian Communication satellite. GSAT-7A is the first satellite built primarily for Indian Air Force to qualitatively unify its assets and improve combined, common intelligence during operation. The Satellite will improve the way Indian Air Force (IAF) interlinks, operates and communicates with its aircrafts during flight with the help of command centres on ground. The satellite will use "Ku band" for superior real time aircraft to aircraft communications. Space Vehicle, GSLV-F11

(Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle) is used to release the satellite to an eventful geostationary orbit about 36000 km from the Earth.

80. Answer – D) Haryana Explanation:

On 18th December 2018, Haryana government launched a mobile App 'Shiksha Setu' to provide students information on attendance, fee, online admission and scholarships of the government colleges of the state. The App will provides instant updates of the important notices, circulars and other programmes to students and teachers. The App will bring transparency in the department and college administration while ensuring better connectivity between students, parents, teachers and officials

Among the states: Kerala, Himachal Pradesh and Tamil Nadu are at the top of the list and running as 'Front Runners' with the scores of 69 each for Kerala and Himachal Pradesh and 66 for Tamil Nadu.

85. Answer – C) December 21**Explanation:**

On 21st December 2018, Winter Solstice which is the shortest day of the year was observed in the Northern Hemisphere whereas the Summer Solstice which is the Longest Day of the year was observed in the Southern Hemisphere. The Summer and Winter Solstices are caused as a result of the tilt of the Earth and its elliptical path around the sun. - New Consumer Protection Bill, 2018 through Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) will be introduced.
- Hon'ble Supreme Court has laid right to speedy justice as a fundamental right of a citizen, implicit in the article 21 of the Constitution of India.

On December 25, 2018, Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated India's longest rail cum road bridge of 4.94 km Bogibeel bridge, which spans the River Brahmaputra between Dibrugarh and Dhemaji districts of Assam. Till now Vembanad rail bridge in Kerala was dubbed as the longest railway-bridge in India at 4.62 km of length. The 4.94 km structure was built at a cost of Rs. 5900 crores by Indian Railways. It is India's only fully welded bridge for which European codes and welding standards were adhered to for the first time in the country. It is also Asia's 2nd longest rail-and-road connector having a life span of 120 years. It will reduce travel time from Assam to Arunachal Pradesh to four hours and will cut out the detour of over 170 km via Tinsukia. It will also cut down train travel between Delhi and Dibrugarh by three hours. Its initial budget was about Rs. 3,200 crore and had an original planned length of 4.31 km.

It started under the name of 'AIE RIVER WINTER FESTIVAL'. The name was officially changed to "Dwijing (river bank in Bodo language)" in 2017. The association of the Hagrama Bridge, the longest rural river bridge of the state, with the festival increased its popularity.

On 26th December 2018, The Reserve Bank of India, in consultation with the government of India has set up a 6-member committee headed by Former RBI Chief Bimal Jalan to review the economic capital framework of the central bank. The committee will suggest how the central bank should handle its reserves and whether it can transfer its surplus to the government. The six-member panel has former deputy RBI governor Rakesh Mohan as its vice chairman and comprises economic affairs secretary Subhash Chandra Garg, RBI central board members Bharat Doshi and Sudhir Mankad and deputy governor NS Viswanathan. The panel will decide whether RBI is holding provisions, reserves and buffers in surplus of the required levels. It would also propose a suitable profits distribution policy taking into account all the likely situations of the RBI. The committee will also suggest an adequate level of risk provisioning that the RBI needs to maintain. Surplus reserves that are created out of realized gains will also come under the jurisdiction of this committee. The panel will submit its report within a period of 90 days from the date of its first meeting.

111. Answer – B) Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012

Explanation:

On December 28, 2018, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi approved the proposal for amendment in the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012. Amendments were made in Section-4, Section-5, Section-6, Section-9, Section-14, Section-15 and Section-42 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012. Amendments in Section-4, Section-5 and Section-6 aims to provide option of stringent punishment, including death penalty, for committing aggravated penetrative

sexual assault crime on a child to protect the children from sexual abuse. Amendments in section-9 to protect children from sexual offences in times of natural calamities and disasters and in cases where children are administered, in any way, any hormone or any chemical substance, to attain early sexual maturity for the purpose of penetrative sexual assault. Amendments of Section-14 and Section-15 aims to address the menace of the child pornography by levying fine further penalizing the perpetrator with jail term or fine or both.

112. Answer – B) Rs 1 lakh**Explanation:**

On 25th December 2018, in order to address the country's current account deficit, Nepal imposed a monthly limit on the amount of Indian currency its citizen can spend in India while paying for goods and services. With the approval of new restrictions a Nepali citizen would be unable to spend more than ₹1 lakh per month while paying for goods and services in India. The policy which came into effect from 25th December 2018 will also be applicable to use of prepaid, credit and debit cards of Nepali banks for purchasing done in Indian Markets. However, the latest measure would exempt payment in hospitals and pharmacies in India. The decision was taken to deal with the growing problem of current account deficit and the balance of payment crisis between India and Nepal.

114. Answer – C) Luka Modric**Explanation:**

On 27th December 2018, Croatia's captain and Spanish club Real Madrid's midfielder Luka Modric was named the Balkan Athlete of the year beating Men's tennis world number one player Novak Djokovic. The poll to name Balkan Athlete of the year was organized by the Bulgarian News Agency (BTA). Serbian player Novak Djokovic got second position whereas women's number one tennis Romania's Simona Halep got third position in the Balkan's poll.

Luka Modric lead Croatia to the FIFA World cup final and bagged player of the tournament for the FIFA 2018 organized in Russia. Modric had also won the prestigious men's Ballon d'Or award for the first time in December 2018.

115. Answer – A) Andry Rajoelina**Explanation:**

On December 27th, 2018, Andry Rajoelina, a former leader of Madagascar has won the country's presidential vote and in the process defeated Marc Ravalomanana, who was another former President of the country. Rajoelina won nearly 56% of the votes and had got 39% of the vote during the first round of the election, whereas, Mr.

Ravalomanana had got 35%. The former president of the country, Henry Rajaonarimampianina was eliminated in the first round of the election as he obtained just 9% of the votes. Both Rajoelina and Ravalomanana are wealthy men and were barred from the 2013 presidential race and had promised to boost the economy of the country. Although, the elections had been beset by allegations of fraud.

On December 28, 2018, the President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, inaugurated the 12th Global Healthcare Summit in Mumbai. It was organized by the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin. In his address he announced that since the launch of Ayushman Bharat in September 2018, 6.5 lakh patients belonging to the deprived families have been hospitalized and over Rs. 850 crore has been spent for their medical treatments.

On December 29, 2018, Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited Varanasi and Ghazipur in Uttar Pradesh for one day. He attended the One District, One Product Regional Summit at Deendayal Hastakala Sankul in Varanasi. Here he laid foundation stone for 14 new development projects worth around 98 crores.
